CHRISTIAN EDUCATION INFORMATION – NURSERY - GRADE 10
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SUNDAY SCHOOL IN A NUTSHELL

Our Sunday School program is open to all children in grades K-8th, with Confirmation programming for 9th and 10th grades. The children will be dismissed during morning worship to class. If you are new or visiting and would like your child to attend class, please join the children at the dismissal at the front of the Sanctuary. The CE Director, Todd Gernes, will be there to help guide all the children to class. We ask that the parents of Grades K-4th please pick up their children after class. Grades 5-8th will be dismissed at the end of class to Jordan Hall.

CHILDCARE:

Childcare is available each Sunday for children under the age of 3. There is a nursery room for infants (newborns through age 18 months) and a Toddler Room (ages 18 months through 3). These rooms are open at 9:50 am for parents/guardians to drop the children off before heading to worship. ***Our Preschool Room now follows the Seasons of the Spirit curriculum. This means that Preschool students begin worship with their families in the sanctuary and recess with the older students after the Children's Moment.***


- A snack of water and Goldfish crackers is given to the Toddlers and Preschool classrooms.
